## • Scene Heading or Slug Line

- Interior or exterior
- The scene location
- Time of day Night Day

### Action Lines

 Paragraph form describing the scene setting. Focus on what the audience will be seeing on screen. Four lines or less.

#### Character

Characters are described for the first time in action lines.

# • Dialogue

- Character names are found above dialogue. Names should be all caps.
- The abbreviation (V.O.) next to the character name stands for Voice Over
- The abbreviation (O.S.) next to the character name stands for off screen

#### Parentheticals

 Usually not used but can be used to describe something that the character is thinking or feeling. Or character positioning

## Transitions

- Used to show how the scene to moving to the next scene;
- o Ex: fade out, cut to, fade in ...

#### Title

## • Camera Directions

o To illustrate the motion of the camera in the scene
