TRADITIONAL IN-SCHOOL INSTRUCTION	
✓	All students and staff are physically present in the school building every day.
✓	The master schedule is followed.
✓	Daily attendance is taken every class period.
✓	Student progress is assessed via the quarterly grading system.
✓	Every Gr. 9-12 student has a Chromebook in their possession.
✓	Teachers and students will utilize a combination of instructional approaches (texts, hands on and 1:1 devices) to cover the curriculum.
✓	IEP & 504 Plans will be implemented and adhered to on a daily basis.

HYBRID INSTRUCTION	
✓	-All staff are physically present in the school building every day. -Students are physically present on alternating days based on the first letter of their last names.
✓	Every Gr. 9-12 student has a Chromebook in their possession.
✓	-On days when students are physically present in school, they will follow the master schedule. -On days when students are learning from home, they will follow the master schedule via their 1:1 devices. Students are expected to sign into each class period on time and to remain present for the duration of the class period.
✓	-Daily attendance will be taken each period for students physically present in school. -Daily attendance will be taken each period for students engaging in class lessons from home.
✓	- In class students will gather each period in their assigned classroom. - At-home students will join each class period via Google Meet. *WebCams and virtual programs (Nearpod, Flipgrid, WeVideo, SeeSaw, etc.) will be utilized to communicate course content and daily lessons to at-home students.

✓	IEP & 504 Plans will be implemented and adhered to on a daily basis.
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REMOTE INSTRUCTION	
✓	-All staff are physically present in the school building every day (unless prohibited by an executive order). -All students learn from home via their 1:1 devices.
✓	The master schedule is followed.
✓	Daily attendance will be taken virtually each period.
✓	Student progress will be assessed via the quarterly grading system.
✓	Every Gr. 9-12 student has a Chromebook in their possession.
✓	Teachers and students will utilize their 1:1 devices to engage in whole group, small group and individualized learning with their assigned class each period.
✓	Classes will gather each period via a Google Meet. Students are expected to sign into each class period on time and to remain present for the duration of the class period. WebCams and virtual programs (Nearpod, Flipgrid, WeVideo, SeeSaw, etc.) will be utilized to cover course content.
✓	IEP & 504 Plans will be implemented and adhered to on a daily basis.

STUDENT USE OF TECHNOLOGY EXPECTATIONS	
✓	<p>Students will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> → sign into every Google Meet on time each day. → display their faces on the screen, and be active participants in the classroom discussions/activities. → be situated at home in surroundings that are conducive to learning. For example, a bed is not an appropriate place from which to learn. Students should be seated at a desk, counter or table; with minimal distractions around them. → be dressed appropriately for the school environment. → respect one another and cooperate with the directives and instructions provided by their teachers. → conduct themselves in a manner that supports not only their ability to learn, but the ability of their classmates to learn. <p><i>*Behavior that disrupts and/or interferes with the learning environment will be addressed as per the district's Code of Conduct.</i></p>
